### ESTATE GROWN

**Terrazas Reserva unoaked Torrontés**, as its name suggests, is not aged in oak barrels, which enhances its intense freshness and its floral and fruity aromas.

**Color:** *It is brilliant green yellowed. with golden highlights.*

**Aroma:** *white flower aromas such as orange blossom and rose combine harmoniously with its intense fruity notes of pear, mango and passion fruit.*

**Palate:** *it is fruity with an excellent acidity expressed in an outstanding freshness. With great aromatic roundness and taste persistence, characteristic of this variety. Elegant and reflect it's personality.*

**Harvest Date:** *second week of March 2008.*

**Vineyard:** *the grapes for this wine grow at 1,800 meters in the province of Salta, to the North of Argentina, where our winemaking team found the ideal conditions for this variety to reveal its maximum expression. With an 18°C / 32° F thermal amplitude, vines are irrigated through furrows or channels.*

**Alcohol:** 13,7%

**pH:** 3,38

**Acidez total:** 5,79 g/l
